There is a \$50 non-member entry fee, which also includes one free 2026 MRA Associate Membership. Any queen contestants who are 2025 MRA Members will receive a free entry with their membership. The 2026 Miss MRA Queen will receive a complimentary 2026 MRA Associate Membership with the title. The MRA Queen can upgrade this membership to a contestant membership if she wishes to do so for an extra fee.

Queen will win a buckle, along with other prizes and complimentary photoshoot from The Rafter JM Photography. Chaps & crown are handed down, year to year but newly selected royalty are welcome to purchase their own set of chaps to wear.

There are no age, marriage or child restrictions on this title, and it is far more open to anyone wanting a wonderful role of representing the sport of rodeo.

Please attach a resume, brief bio and 5x7 headshot photo. (Resume can include any prior involvement in the MRA and other horse related activities.)

Eligibility requirements

- Age: Contestants must be 18 or older as of January 1st of the current competition year.
- Relationship status: You can be single, dating or married.
- Other titles: You cannot currently hold a royalty title from any other organization but can for saddle clubs or rodeos within our Association.
- **Horse ownership:** Contestants must compete on their own horse or a horse owned by an immediate family member (mother, father, sister, or brother).
- \$50 Entry fee. Stalls \$100 for weekend with 2 bags of shavings included. NO tie out or pens allowed. Electrical spots are \$25 per day Dry camping is allowed for no charge.
